She graduated from the School of Rural and Surveying Engineering, National Technical University of Athens, Greece (NTUA) in 1983. Her Ph.D. thesis was in the field of Cadastre/LIS and Land Policy entitled “*Use of Existing Cadastral Information*” at the National Technical University of Athens, in 1996.

During her graduate studies she worked as a teaching assistant and in 2004 she was elected as a Lecturer in the field of “*Cadastre and Spatial Information Management*” at the School of Rural and Surveying Engineering, National Technical University of Athens. Between 2000 and 2006 she was also visiting Assistant Professor at the School of Architecture, University of Patras, teaching Topography, Cartography and GIS.

She participated in 10 educational seminars as instructor. She supervised, as principal supervisor, 30 diploma theses and 8 post graduate theses; she is also principal supervisor in 3 Ph.D theses.

She is elected as Associate Professor at the National Technical University of Athens, (NTUA) and she is actively involved as a senior expert in a number of studies and research projects relevant to her field of expertise. Her teaching activity as Lecturer and Assistant Professor at the NTUA consists of 32 semesters of undergraduate courses and 10 semesters of postgraduate courses in the fields of Cadastral, Land Information Systems and Land Policy. She also participated as Committee member for the reform of the Post Graduate Study Program “*Environment and Development*”.

She peer-reviewed 28 articles (CEUS, International Journal of Information and Decision Sciences, Waste Management and Congress Proceedings).
